## **Retail Trade Indices (RTI)**

September 2024. Provisional data

### Main results

- The annual rate of the General Retail Trade Index at constant prices stood at 4.1% in the seasonal and calendar adjusted series.
- The monthly variation in retail sales at constant prices was 1.0% after seasonal and calendar adjustment.
- Employment in retail trade increased by 1.7% in annual rate.



In September, the General Retail Trade Index at constant prices, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 4.1% as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.7 points higher than the one registered in August.

The original RTI series at constant prices registered an annual variation of 1.7%, this rate was 1.4 points below the rate of the previous month.

Annual rates. Percentage






## Monthly trend of sales in retail trade

The monthly variation of the RTI between the months of September and August, stood at 1.0%. This rate was six tenths higher than the previous month.

### General Retail Trade Index at constant prices


Seasonally and calendar adjusted. Monthly rate. Percentage



By distribution type, *Department stores* increased the most (2.1%).

The general index, excluding service stations, recorded a monthly rate of 0.9%. By products, *Food* increased by 1.0% and *Non-food products* by 1.0%.

# Sales indices at constant prices. General and by type of product. September 2024 Seasonally and calendar adjusted. Monthly rate. Percentage






## **Results by Autonomous Community**

Retail sales at constant prices increased in the annual rate in 14 Autonomous Communities in September and decreased in three. País Vasco registered the largest increase (3.6%) and Principado de Asturias the largest decrease (1.0%).

## **Employment trend**

In September, the employment index in the retail trade sector registered a variation of 1.7% as compared to the same month of 2023. This rate was three tenths below that recorded in August.

## Revisions and update of data

On the press release day, INE has updated RTI data series corresponding to the last three months. In the case of calendar adjusted and seasonally and calendar adjusted series, according to INE standard, series are revised since its beginning. Results are available on INEbase.

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Retail Trade Indices (RTI) is to ascertain the fundamental characteristics of the companies engaged in retail trade in Spain, which make it possible to measure, in the short term, the trend of activity in the sector.

Survey type: continuous monthly survey.

Base year: 2021.

Population scope: companies whose main activity is included within division 47 of the CNAE-2009 Retail

trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles.

Geographical scope: the whole country.

Sample size: Approximately 12,000 companies. Type of sampling: stratified random sampling.

Collection method: fill in a questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet

(IRIA system), e-mail, fax, telephone or by post.
